Result of examination:

The submitted evidence was searched through the Anonymous Letter File, Bank Robbery Note File and other files containing similar type messages at this Bureau without effecting a definite identification.

As related in the telephone call August 11, 1977 to Detective [redacted] two anonymous letters, handwriting, upper- and lower-case hand printing of DAVID R. BERKOWITZ were received in this Laboratory on June 27, 1977 from the Police Department, Yonkers, New York. As could be determined from the available writings, characteristics were noted in a portion of the hand printed address which indicate that dictated handwriting and hand printing prepared by BERKOWITZ in the same wording of the questioned writings be obtained in that case.

Comparison of the upper-case hand printing of BERKOWITZ with the questioned upper-case hand printing in the instant case also suggests the desirability of obtaining additional hand printing of this individual should a future examination be requested.

The submitted photographs are retained for any future examinations requested.

Twenty-four latent fingerprints, twelve of which are extreme tip or side impressions, one latent impression, which is either a fingerprint or partial palm print, and seventeen latent palm prints are present in nine of the submitted photographs. Some of the latent prints are also present in the remaining photographs.

One of the latent fingerprints is not identical with the fingerprints of David R. Berkowitz. The remaining latent fingerprint and impression have been compared, insofar as possible, with the fingerprints of Berkowitz, but no identification was effected. For conclusive comparisons of these latent prints, inked impressions of the extreme tips and sides of the fingers of Berkowitz will be necessary. There are no palm prints in our Identification Division files for Berkowitz.

Photographs of the latent prints have been prepared for our files and will be available for any additional comparisons you may desire.

Should you desire the assistance of one of the FBI's fingerprint experts in the trial of this case, we should be notified in ample time to permit the necessary arrangements. This report should be used, however, if legal considerations permit, in lieu of the appearance of our expert in any pre-trial action such as a preliminary hearing or grand jury hearing. Our representative cannot be made available to testify if any other fingerprint expert is to present testimony on the same point, that is, that the impressions in question are identical.

You will receive a separate report regarding the result of our laboratory examination.

The specimens are being retained.
