- On 10/23 at 0330 hrs., I responded to Flushing Hospital located in confines 109 Pat. I was accompanied by Det. R. Drucker #3972 assigned 105 PIU and Sgt. Black #955 assigned 112 PIU.
- At this time, I conducted interview of [redacted] F/W/21 [redacted] and her boyfriend, [redacted], both of Queens. Interview conducted in regards to shots being fired at persons above which caused injury to Bekere.
- Facts are as follows according to complainants. The above mentioned complainants had left Pecks Bar & Grill located at 160 St. and Depot Road, at 0200 hrs. in [redacted] auto, 1970 Volkswagon, blue, bearing plates [redacted]. They drove to location at 160 St., between 32 & 33 Aves. They were parked there for about 5 minutes when they heard loud explosion nearby and windows on auto shattered. [redacted] realized he had been struck and felt blood. They then drove back to bar and police were called from there.
- Complainants cannot account for this incident and investigation reveals that auto was struck multiple times. One bullet recovered from auto at this time and vouchered at 109 Pat. Incident occurred at about 0215 hrs.

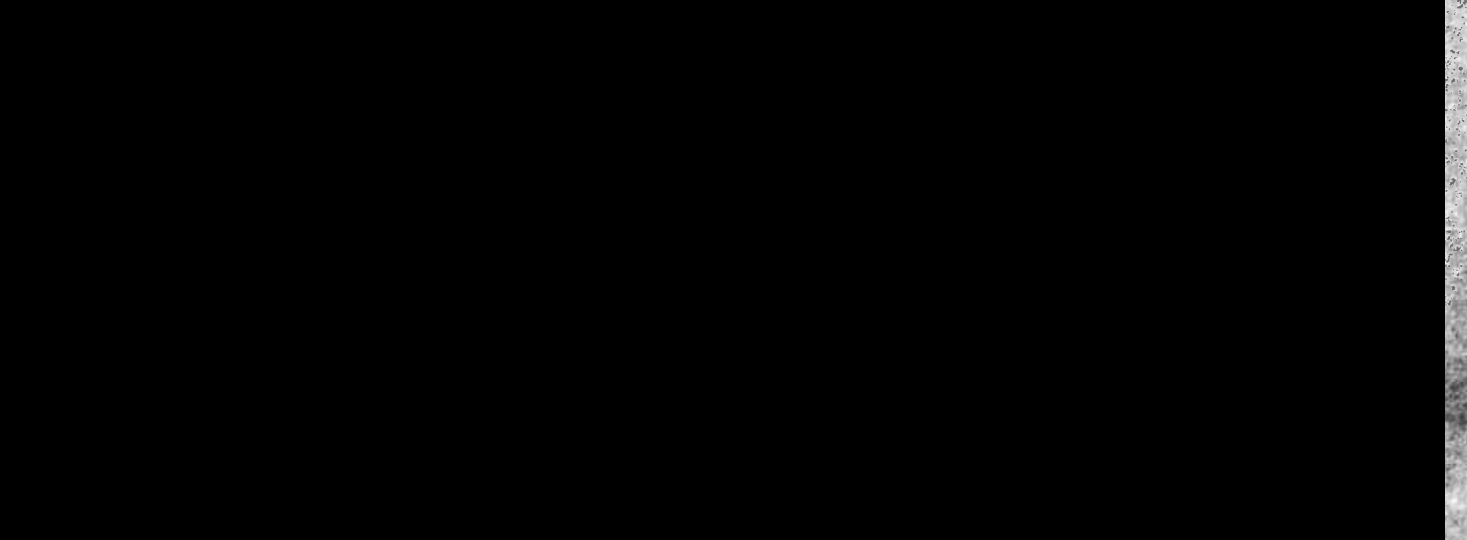

1. On 10/23/76 at about 8:30 P.M. discussed case and examined auto with Dets. Kane & Kuhn from Forensic. It was established that three or four shots were fired from a large caliber weapon (only one to weight of slug found in speedometer) from the right rear rear of auto. (See Forensic report attached) The auto, a 1970 dark blue V.W. has the bullet hole on the exterior, right side, one on the slope of roof above right rear door, one on right door frame rear of door and just under back window, empty slug exit hole indicating shot from right rear. On the inside of auto by floor found, the in speedometer the other in lower window frame (interior of door) - slug seated, both are badly serrated and sent to Ballistics for examination. The other slug, and by complaint, located in rear wall behind rear seat, located on floor, in visible hole in the area, other holes found on inside of outside of auto. This slug also sent to Ballistics for examination.
