On the above date, the undersigned officers met at the Detective Division with Senior Det. Investigator Massiah and Det. Inv. Lopez of the Brooklyn District Attorney's Office who are handling all interviews and any additional information that can be obtained regarding the "SON OF SAM" case.

At the Detective Division, they requested if we had any information that could be supplied to them pertaining to the arrest of the "SON OF SAM" and also, possibly, names of the people living at [REDACTED]. This information was given to them orally and also, a copy of the letter sent by David Berkowitz to Sam and Wheat Carr from the Kings County Hospital, was also given to them with the authority of Capt. Jones.

While at the Detective Division, Sam Carr along with his daughter, Wheat Carr, entered the office and at this time, requested to speak with the Detectives who were from the District Attorney's Office and Kings County.

At this time, they interviewed both Sam and Wheat Carr relative to the case in an attempt to ascertain any additional information that might have been overlooked prior to them doing the investigation.
