At location, spoke to Assistant Chief Kelly of the Fire Department, who stated that firefighters had extinguished a small blaze on the exterior part of a three-floor woodframe building located at **Address**

Investigation by assigned revealed that a fire apparently started by a thrown molotov cocktail at approximately 3:30AM this date.

Assigned spoke to Mrs. Margaret DiGuardi, **Gender & Race** years, of **Address** who stated that at approximately 3:30AM this date, she heard a crash in the vicinity of **Address** ^{House No} st. She looked out from the window of her home which is adjacent to **Address** and observed flames around second floor window area of home. She called Mr. Neto, who she knows personally, and then called Yonkers Fire Department and reported fire. Mr. Neto and a Mr. DiAcutis and other neighbors extinguished fire partially with garden hoses prior to arrival of Fire Department. Mrs. DiGuardi stated that she did not see anyone after hearing the crash of glass but stated that in the past, both she and other neighborhood people had been bothered by young black youths in area who throw stones at windows and also had been in rear yards and break statutes and lawn furniture.

Investigation by assigned revealed dog had apparently been shot from north side of the street, whereas said bullet penetrated the a chainlink fence hitting said dog and going through same.

Further investigation revealed that after said bullet passed through said dog, same had bounced off a wooden step in an unknown direction. Assigned further observed that two bullets had penetrated the alluminum siding just above where said German Shepherd had been shot. An attempt by assigned officers to retrieve said bullets, proved negative at this date due to the fact that Mr. Neto did not wish assigned officers to pry open alluminum siding in order to obtain said bullets.

Mr. Neto stated that he would in fact notify the contractor who had placed alluminum siding on said building in the AM in order for him to dislocate alluminum siding from buidling without damaging same. This letter was not signed and it was immediately destroyed by Mrs. Neto's mother and sister. Mrs. Neto was not informed of this letter at that time because she was suffering from a nervous condition. The Police Department was not notified of this letter.

Mrs. Neto stated that at no time did she receive any other letters nor did she receive any threatening telephone calls.
