Mr. Carr stated that he was contacted by a Mrs. Jack Cassara of Address [REDACTED], relative to a Get-Well Card sent to her on June 6, 1977 and with the return address of Mr. & Mrs. Samuel Carr, [REDACTED]

The letter in essence stated:

Dear Jack: I'm sorry to hear about that fall you took from the roof of your home. Just want to say I'm sorry but I'm sure it won't be long until you feel much better, happy, well and strong. Please be careful next time since you are going to be confined for a long time, let us know if Nan needs anything. Sincerely, Sam and Francis". Mr. Carr stated to Mrs. Cassara that he does not know her and they arranged a meeting on the night of June 9, 1977 to compare handwriting on envelope with letters received by Mr. Carr. It should be noted that the writing and the return address appears to be the same type that was in the threatening letters of these reports. Ms. Cassara stated that she had a tenant in January and February of 1976 whose name was David R. Berkowitz, M/W, approx. 20-22 years of age and the man did not seem to be in a proper mental state and left her home after living there for approx. one month as a tenant.

It should be noted that a David R. Berkowitz also lives at 35 Pine Street, Yonkers, N.Y. dob 6/1/53 who might possibly be the same man that lived with the Cassaras and might have been responsible for writing letters to both Mrs. Cassara and Mr. Carr. Assigned learned from Mr. Carr that Berkowitz supposedly attempted to work as a guard at Neptune Stores in New Rochelle but Mr. Carr does not know if he is still employed. He believed that man had possibly a pistol permit and might be responsible for his dog's shooting. Assigned checked with Det. Benjamin and learned that no David R.

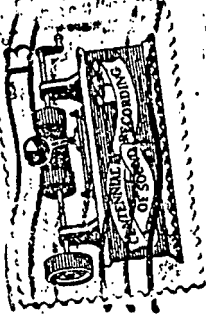
No, we cannot ~~afford~~ afford to move, our home is here.

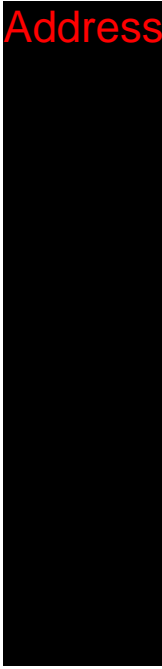

SAMUEL CARR NOTIFIED BY PHONE (ASSIGNED CHECKING WITH COLLEGE AS COMPLAINANT WAS NOT AT HOME.
