Ms. Cassara stated that she had a tenant in January and February of 1976 whose name was David R. Berkowitz, M/W, approx. 20-22 years of age and the man did not seem to be in a proper mental state and left her home after living there for approx. one month as a tenant.

It should be noted that a David R. Berkowitz also lives at 35 Pine Street, Yonkers, N.Y. dob 6/1/53 who might possibly the same man that lived with the Cassaras and might have been responsible for writing letters to both Mrs. Cassara and Mr. Carr. Assigned learned from Mr. Carr that Berkowitz susposedly attempted to work as a guard at Neptune Stores in New Rochelle but Mr. Carr does not know if he is still employed. He believed that man had possibly a pistol permit and might be responsible for his dog's shooting. Assigned checked with Det. Benjamin and learned that no David R.


