The assigned proceeded back to the Intelligence Unit with Det. Donnelly and at this point, left him with Det. Grogan.

The assigned proceeded back to-Headquarters and turned over the listed photocopies to Det. Mike Lorenzo under the direction of Det. Lt. Harry Nasce.
