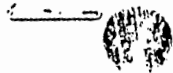

On August 4, 1977, the undersigned officers conducted a canvass in the area of Bay 17th St., between Shore Parkway and Cropsey Ave., in connection with the above mentioned homicide.

At approximately 1500 hours, Mrs. [REDACTED] was interviewed at her place of residence, [REDACTED]. Mrs. [REDACTED] stated that parking summonses had been served on the evening of the Moskowitz homicide. She was certain of this fact since she herself was issued a summons in the close proximity of the crime at the time of its commission.

Upon returning to the 10th Homicide Zone, at approximately 1745 hours, this information was discussed with Lt. McCarthy and Sgt. Gardella, in the presence of Deputy Chief Fitzpatrick.

The superior officers present indicated that this area of investigation had already been explored. Inquiries into the possible issuance of parking summonses, at the time and place of the homicide, had all met with negative results.

The undersigned officers volunteered to investigate this matter further after being advised that no compensation could be authorized for overtime.

At approximately 1820 hours the assigned officers returned to the residence of Mrs. [REDACTED] and obtained the following information:

Mrs. [REDACTED] further stated that other vehicles, in the vicinity of the homicide, were also ticketed on the night in question.

At approximately 1900 hours this information was given to Lt. Powers at the 10th Homicide Zone. The reporting officers stated that the perpetrator of the homicide may also have had a summons issued to his vehicle. It was also requested that issuing Police Officer Cataneo be interviewed, in the event that other summonses were served and the possibility that the perpetrator may have been observed by the R.M.P. team.

On the following day August 5, 1977, Sgt. Gardella was also advised of the above information.

The undersigned officers are firmly convinced that the information as originally reported to Lt. Powers and again to Sgt. Gardella had a direct bearing on initiating a complete and thorough search of summonses issued. It was the discovery of the now famous parking summons which ultimately resulted in the identification and apprehension of the perpetrator.

The letter was read to the mother by [redacted] who lives at the same address with her husband [redacted] for the last four years. She remembered the contents in substance as follows: "The Devil will come with dogs; the devil will burn down your house; Fire of Hell will burn your house. Lt. Starkey stated that fire apparently was deliberate set since same (residue) indicated garbage piled directly in front of doorway of [redacted] Fire burned a door frames severely, smoke blacked Eastern end of hallway. No estimation of damage, at this time, apparent to the assigned that damage is in excess of one thousand dollars (\$1,000).

The assigned spoke to the complainant, Craig Glassman, M/W, 29 yrs. of age, home phone [redacted] Mr. Glassman stated that at approximately 7:30AM, this date, he was sleeping and he woke up upon hearing popping sounds coming from the hallway. He stated that he glanced towards the doorway entrance to apartment and saw smoke seeping in under the doorway around frames. He also stated, at this time, that he heard voices in the hallway but he did not open the door, at this particular time. These bullets were retrieved and in custody in the Property Clerk's Office of this department.

Further conversation with the complainant revealed that he has received several threatening letters from an apparently unknown persons in regards to doing damage to him. Said letters are signed, "Your brother Deso Demesmutz." It should be stated, for the purpose of this report, that the type of letter received are of the same type letters received in C&R#: 20292 - DD#: 2144-N, dated April 24, 1977. In this particular case, Samuel Carr, W/M, 63 yrs., of [REDACTED] is the complainant, Dets assigned are R. Baker and W. Kennedy; also M. Lorenzo doing follow-up regarding these threatening letters. In that reports, indications are that one David Berkowitz, W/M, 24 yrs., of age [REDACTED] might be the perpetrator sending threatening letters. Mr. Berkowitz drives a 1974 Yellow, registration 561-XLB, NY Registration. Merkowitz DOB is [REDACTED]. Several other letters that Mr. Glassman received are in custody of the Westchester County Sheriff's Department where he is employed with Corporal Status. Deputy Sheriff David Feliciano, Sheriff's Office is handling letters investigation for Sheriff's Department. Letter recovered this date, matches samples in April 1977 threatening letters case involving Mr. Carr.

Please refer to April 1977 threatening letter job in cross reference in regards to suspected arson.

The assigned questioned several other tenants on the floor but no one saw nor heard anything other than the previously mentioned [REDACTED] - [REDACTED] couple. The assigned and Det. Lorenzo proceeded to [REDACTED] in an attempt to locate one David Berkowitz, unable, at this time to locate Berkowitz at home. A check of the immediate area revealed his car previously mentioned not in parking lot or general vicinity of the [REDACTED] address.

Lt. Starkey of the Fire Department retrieved piece of carpet which lines entire hallway and sent same to Lab to be tested to see if accelerant was used to start fire, but in his opinion he does not think so, at this time.

This investigation to be continued by Det. Mike Lorenzo and also Jose Feliciano of the Sheriff's Department who came to this office approximately 11:30AM, this date and was filled in as to the progress of both threatening letters and arson investigation, as aforesaid, Sheriff's Department is conducting their own investigation in regards to threatening letters received by the complainant on other dates. The information which he relayed from those letters and which are in the custody of the Sheriff's Department indicate to Det. Lorenzo that responsible persons wrote same to Carr-complainant in April 77 Job and also wrote letter found in this complainant's apartment this date, and same attached to and made a part of this report.

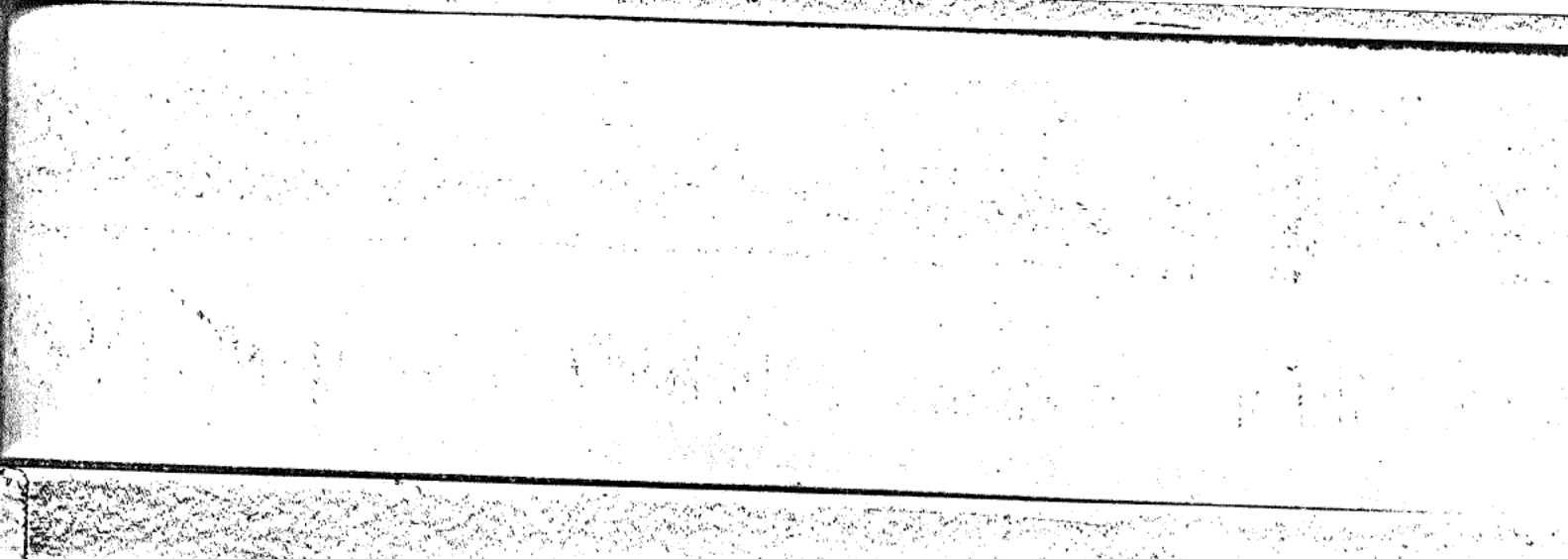

On August 4, 1977, the undersigned officers conducted a canvass in the area of Bay 17th St., between Shore Parkway and Cropsy Ave., in connection with the above mentioned homicide.

At approximately 1500 hours, Mrs. [REDACTED] was interviewed at her place of residence, [REDACTED]. Mrs. [REDACTED] stated that parking summonses had been served on the evening of the Moskowitz homicide. She was certain of this fact since she herself was issued a summons in the close proximity of the crime at the time of its commission.

Upon returning to the 10th Homicide Zone, at approximately 1745 hours, this information was discussed with Lt. McCarthy and Sgt. Gardella, in the presence of Deputy Chief Fitzpatrick.

The superior officers present indicated that this area of investigation had already been explored. Inquiries into the possible issuance of parking summonses, at the time and place of the homicide, had all met with negative results.

The undersigned officers volunteered to investigate this matter further after being advised that no compensation could be authorized for overtime.

At approximately 1820 hours the assigned officers returned to the residence of Mrs. [REDACTED] and obtained the following information:

Mrs. [REDACTED] further stated that other vehicles, in the vicinity of the homicide, were also ticketed on the night in question.

At approximately 1900 hours this information was given to Lt. Powers at the 10th Homicide Zone. The reporting officers stated that the perpetrator of the homicide may also have had a summons issued to his vehicle. It was also requested that issuing Police Officer Cataneo be interviewed, in the event that other summonses were served and the possibility that the perpetrator may have been observed by the R.M.P. team.

On the following day August 5, 1977, Sgt. Gardella was also advised of the above information.

The undersigned officers are firmly convinced that the information as originally reported to Lt. Powers and again to Sgt. Gardella had a direct bearing on initiating a complete and thorough search of summonses issued. It was the discovery of the now famous parking summons which ultimately resulted in the identification and apprehension of the perpetrator.
