On 2-2-77, the assigned together with Sgt. Coffey received permission from the deceased's parents to look through her room for any evidence that may be helpful in this investigation. Among the items removed was a love letter sent by [redacted] of [redacted] to John Diel. A photo-copy letter and a photograph of John Diel and Ms. [redacted] which was sent by the deceased to Ms. [redacted] was also discovered. Another letter removed was a response to the first letter by Ms. [redacted] to the deceased. The contents of these letters reveals the deceased's discovery of a love affair between Ms. [redacted] and John Diel and the deceased's desire to expose this affair to Ms. [redacted]'s husband.

On 2-9-77, the officers interviewed [redacted] of [redacted], N.Y.C. (deceased's employer at [redacted]), as a result of Mr. [redacted] call to this office of information that he had relative to the deceased. Mr. [redacted] says that he was aware of the above information because he was apprised by the deceased in October of 1976. It was his opinion that the letter was received by Ms. [redacted] without any knowledge by her husband and apparently the situation was resolved.

On 2-10-77, the assigned spoke to Mrs. [redacted] of [redacted], [redacted]. She says that the deceased had told her of the above information and to her knowledge the situation was resolved.

..... On 2-15-77, the officers interviewed [REDACTED] of [REDACTED] [REDACTED] (friend of the deceased). She also indicated that she was aware of this affair and the action that the deceased had taken when the first letter was found by the deceased. It was apparent to Ms. [REDACTED] that the deceased wanted to sever this relation and wanted to reveal it to Ms. [REDACTED]'s husband to do so. As far as Ms. [REDACTED] was concerned the situation was over.

On 3-2-77, John Diel was the subject of a polygraph test conducted at the Police Academy by Det. Fred Sanchez. The test encompassed the crime as well as Mr. Diel's affair with Ms. [REDACTED]. It is the opinion of Det. Sanchez that this subject was truthful and non-evasive in his answers. The assigned then questioned Mr. Diel regarding the love affair and he says that the ~~situa~~ situation was resolved a short while later after the letter to him from Ms. [REDACTED] was discovered by the deceased.

On 3-3-77, the officers interviewed [REDACTED] of [REDACTED] [REDACTED] Mrs. [REDACTED] indicated that she is a close friend of Ms. [REDACTED] and is frequently in touch with her. Ms. [REDACTED] had told her that the affair was resolved even though she is still in love with Mr. Diel. Ms. [REDACTED] also says that her husband was told by her about her feelings for John, but his attitude was of forgiveness. Mrs. [REDACTED] says that neither Ms. [REDACTED] or her husband has been back to this country since they had left in September of 1976.

A check with the Dept. of Immigration and Naturalization, U.S. Govt., by Sgt. Coffey was made, and according to Mr. Kersaules, an agent of that department indicated that there is no record of either Mr. or Mrs. [REDACTED] that had entered this country since September of 1976.
