The assigned interviewed above 1020 hrs. 3/9/77 at the 15th Homicide Office. Subject is employed as a student teacher at Queens College. She came to this country 8 yrs ago with her family from Sofia, Bulgaria.

Regarding her sister Virginia she stated that she is presently attending Columbia University since Sept. 1976 studying languages. She transferred from Queens College where she spent two years.

She has been going with [REDACTED] M-W-27 yrs. a teacher of Russian Language at Columbia University for the past year. She is also in his class for Russian language. Deceased last spoke to [REDACTED] on Tuesday 3/8/77 sometime in late afternoon in his class. The conversation was short and deceased stated that she was going home after school.

Deceased travelled by subway from 71st St. and Continental Ave. to the Bronx. She sometimes took a bus from subway station at Continental Ave. and got off at 69th and Exeter St. However in the nice weather she walks from subway station to her residence.

Prior to seeing [REDACTED] she went with a boy named [REDACTED] (last name or address unk.) lives somewhere in Whitestone, Queens. She went with him for two years.
