

In the early 1970s, Alfonso Carozza, 22 Wicker St., Yonkers, and one Anthony Carozza, born 1903, went into a partnership in a pizza shop in New Rochelle.

Joseph Carozza underwrote the loan for the business. Joseph Carozza was killed Dec. 31, 1981 on his yacht in New Rochelle. 38 Caliber gun.

Alfonso Carozza ties to the "22 Disciples of Hell" alias in the SOS letter to Breslin, and to the "Wicked King Wicker" alias (King Alfonso, see dictionary) in that same letter.

Anthony Carozza, after the pizza business went under in 1973, moved to Phoenix, Arizona, and currently resides there.

Alfonso Carozza, DOB 3/21/46, was involved in a motorcycle accident in Yonkers (Saw Mill Pkwy) the day after Berkowitz was arrested (accident: 8/11/77). Alfonso's NY driver's license expired on 3/21/78 (a month after John Carr's demise) and he has not been heard of since in NY area.

However, from Phoenix, home of Anthony Carozza, Alfonso's partner, has come a series of letters re: God, satan, the Bronfman family and other bizarre subjects. These letters were addressed to, among others, Ronald Regan, a handful of senators, and the mayor of Yonkers. The letters are signed King Alfonso. Last name Lizanetz, which is in the same league with aliases such as Czarnakowski, etc, which were labels used by the late Michael Carr.
