Dear Sir:

Article 12-B, Section 259-i of the Executive Law requires that in any case where a person is received in an institution under the jurisdiction of the Department of Correctional Services with an indeterminate sentence wherein the Court has not fixed a minimum period of imprisonment, the Board of Parole must set the minimum period of imprisonment. The Executive Law specifies that the Board of Parole give due consideration to the recommendations of the sentencing Court, the District Attorney and the Attorney for the inmate, in fixing a minimum period of imprisonment.

The above-named person was recently convicted by the Court and will be appearing before the Parole Board for purpose of determining the minimum period of imprisonment. The members of the Parole Board would appreciate receiving any statements or recommendations you may care to present, with reference to your knowledge of this case which might be pertinent to their determination.

In addition to the recommendation of the Court, a copy of the sentencing minutes is requested.

If no reply is received within 20 days, it will be assumed that you do not wish to make any recommendation.
