


On this date the undersigned and Detective Joseph Brundage, drove Joseph Savino to Jacobi Hospital to see his wife [REDACTED]. Mr. [REDACTED] was interviewed during the ride and at the Hospital and stated the following.

Prior to going to Nino's for dinner, he was at the [REDACTED] with a friend named [REDACTED] publisher of the [REDACTED], and he [REDACTED] writes a column for. They had several drinks, when his wife, [REDACTED] arrived at about 8:30 P.M., mentioning that the babysitter was late. Mr. [REDACTED] had another drink and left to keep another appointment. [REDACTED] and his wife left as she expressed a desire to have Shrimps at Nino's, they left the [REDACTED] together but driving thier own autos (Hers a 1976 Jaguar) she following him, in his 1974 Mark IV, they arrived at Nino's at the same time, and she parked in the parking lot, and he parked in the street (Bouck Ave.)parallel to her car. They had dinner some more drinks, and made some phone calls, when they were about to leave he made one more call, to his girlfriend, his wife was in conversation with a female and her husband, who were sitting nearby (see D.D. # 5). They left the resturant together and his wife got into her car, he got into his and drove away, making the




On this date at 0040 hrs. [REDACTED] returned to Nina's restaurant, he was met by the owner [REDACTED] and all the waitresses who explained to him what had happened and gave [REDACTED] pocketbook, which contained all of her jewelry, which had been removed prior to her going to the Hospital. After several minuets, while [REDACTED] had a drink and discussed the case, he was seperated from them and briefly interviewed by the assigned. He appeared slightly dazed-very low keyed, and a little incoherent. He stated that he took his wife to Nina's for her last meal of Nina's cooking, because she was due to go to England and visit her family on Saturday. He was vague as to times. He said they left the restaurant together (not sure of the time) and they walked back to the parking lot; she waved and got into her car. I waved and got into my car and drove off. I just made the light on the corner (Boston Rd. & Bouck) made a right turn slowed, stopped and waited a couple of minuets... I figured she got caught at the light so I drove on home. He made reference to her new car, stating "It's a brand new car, she always wanted a Jag.. she babied it. When asked to explain the reason for two cars, he stated that she met him at the [REDACTED] for a drink, and she liked the shrimps at Nina's, so we drove there for dinner. He made no mention of having made or receiving any phone call and the subject was not broached. 0330 Hrs. Crime scene secured. Undersigned drove Victim's Jaguar to the 47th Pct. There it was vouchered for safekeeping by P.O. Cifone.



On this date the undersigned in the company of Detective Brundage, interviewed Mrs. [REDACTED], on the treatment table in the emergency room at Jacobi Hospital. Mrs. [REDACTED] stated that she had just entered her auto, when a unknown male approached the car, she thought it was the owner of the auto that was parked next to her's, which was exactly the same make, year and color (1976 Jagur Grey), the next thing she saw was the unknown male pointing at her and he was smiling, and shot her several times, and walked around the rear of her auto and out of the parking lot. Mrs. [REDACTED] gave the following description of the person.
 M W 30s 5'9" Black Hair, Black leather jacket, no further.
 Mrs. [REDACTED] could not be questioned any further at this time.
