Motion is made by the court appointed Conservator of defendant David Berkowitz, Conservatee, for delivery to her of certain tapes sealed by order of this court.

The tapes which the Conservator seeks are recordings of conversations by the defendant and Philip Peltz, who originally represented the defendant in the early stages of the criminal proceedings and which tapes were impounded by the court and presently are in the custody of the Clerk of said court.

The Conservator's purpose is to establish a fund with which to pay for expenses of the administration of the conservatorship and the defense of 10 civil actions for death and/or personal injuries being prosecuted against the defendant and for payment of any judgments or other claims which may be recovered in the said civil actions.

A possible source of said funds (the estate being without assets of any kind) is the receipt of monies which may be received for the sale of literary, movie and television rights of the defendant's story. The Conservator has advised the court that at the time of this writing, the defendant is disinclined to cooperate in the publishing of any such material.

The Conservator seeks possession of these tapes in order to commence negotiations to maximize the selling price of these tapes to potential publishers and purchasers. The funds thus obtained can then be


Gentlemen:

Leon Stern, the attorney of record for the defendant opposes the Conservator's application on the ground that there is no compelling need at this time for the release and possible publication of the tape recordings. Furthermore, Mr. Stern has cross moved for an order directing the Clerk of this court to deliver to him the very same tapes. Mr. Stern advised that neither he nor his co-counsel, Ira J. Jultak have been paid for the services rendered to David Berkowitz. He also seeks a preferred lien for himself and Mr. Jultak for reasonable counsel fees and disbursements from any funds which may be established.

While the court is aware of the substantial legal work done by Leon Stern and his co-counsel, Ira Jultak both in the criminal and civil proceedings involving the defendant, the court will not pass upon the method, amount or priority of the claims of Leon Stern and Ira Jultak. Such determination shall await the successful establishment of a fund to pay all proper claims.

Accordingly, the court directs the Clerk of this court to deliver and release to Doris Johnson, the Conservator of David Berkowitz, the sealed tape recordings. The Conservator, on notice to all claimants, shall seek court approval prior to the sale or publication of any of the tapes or the information contained therein.
