Dear Mr. Peltz:

Please be advised that pursuant to Section 632(a) of the Executive Law of the State of New York as amended 1977 that any monies owing to David Berkowitz or his representatives as a result of the crimes of which he has been accused of committing shall be paid over to the Crime Victims Compensation Board for distribution to the victims of such crimes in the event of the conviction of Mr. Berkowitz for the crimes alleged.

"Every person, firm, corporation, partnership, association or other legal entity contracting with any person or the representative or assignee of any person, accused of a crime in this state, with respect to the re-enactment of such crime, by way of a movie, book, magazine article, radio or television presentation, live entertainment of any kind, or from the expression of such person's thoughts, feelings, opinions or emotions regarding such crime, shall pay over to the Crime Victims Compensation Board any monies which would otherwise, by terms of such contract, be owing to the person so convicted or his representatives..." (Sec. 632(a), Executive Law, State of New York.)
