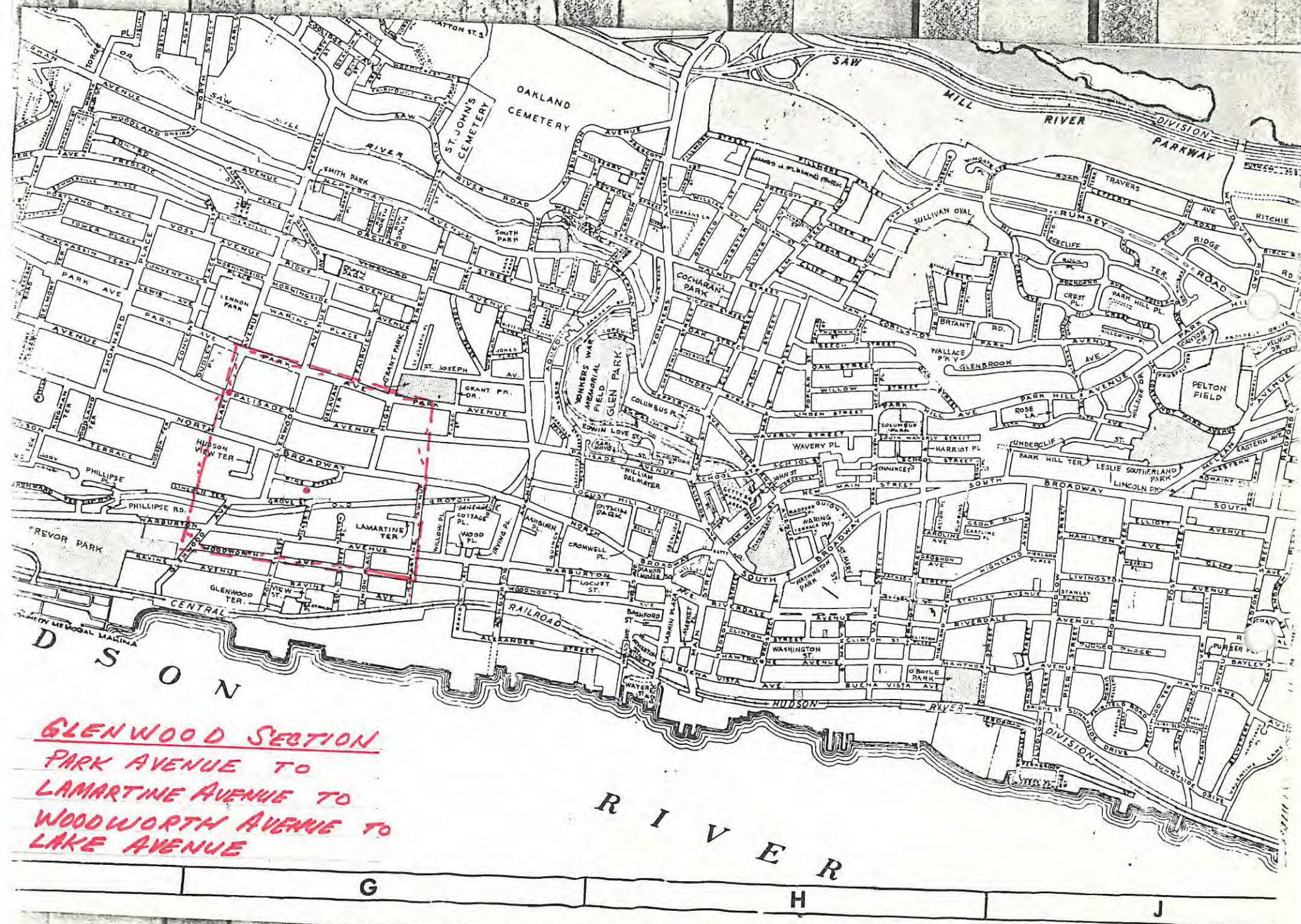
Result of examination:

It was determined that Q1 and Q2 were prepared by the writer of the Samuel Carr and Sam Carr letters which have been designated Qc3 and Qc4 submitted by the Chief of Police, Yonkers, New York with letter dated 6/23/77.

The only available known handwriting of David R. Berkowitz consists of his signature. Q1 and Q2 are not sufficiently comparable in letters or letter combinations with the David R. Berkowitz signature for meaningful handwriting comparisons to be made. Therefore, it was not possible to determine whether Q1 and Q2 were or were not prepared by Berkowitz. If a future examination is requested efforts should be made to obtain dictated handwriting in the complete wording of Q1 and Q2 prepared by Berkowitz. Q1 and Q2 should not be shown to Berkowitz prior to obtaining the dictated handwritten specimens.

The submitted evidence has been photographed and is returned herewith.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION AND DETAILED REPORT

August 6, 1977

The assigned, Dets. Spivey & M. Urquhart sent to the place of occurrence, [redacted] apt. [redacted] by D.O. R. Del Bene in regards to a possible arson. The assigned proceeded and upon arrival spoke to Fire Lt. Starkey in charge of the Fire Bureau Arson Squad who stated that they received an alarm of fire at the place of occurrence at approximately 7:30AM, this date with Engine & on Shonnard Terrace responding to same under the command of Assist. Chief Ryan. Upon the arrival of the firemen, the fire was 90 percent out, due to tenants in the building pouring water on same.

Lt. Starkey stated that fire apparently was deliberate set since same (residue) indicated garbage piled directly in front of doorway of apt. [redacted] Fire burned a door frames severely, smoke blacked Eastern end of hallway. No estimation of damage, at this time, apparent to the assigned that damage is in excess of one thousand dollars (\$1,000).

The assigned spoke to the complainant, Craig Glassman, M/W, 29 yrs. of age, home phone # [redacted] Mr. Glassman stated that at approximately 7:30AM, this date, he was sleeping and he woke up upon hearing popping sounds coming from the hallway. He stated that he glanced towards the doorway entrance to apartment and saw smoke seeping in under the doorway around frames. He also stated, at this time, that he heard voices in the hallway but he did not open the door, at this particular time. He called outside to two voices asking if there was a fire and he received an affirmative answer and was told to wait until they put it out and then he could open the door. Also, visiting from Florida is the father of Mr. Glassman, [redacted], and sleeps in a bed in the studio-type of apartment.

The assigned spoke to the following named persons: [redacted], 32 yrs., B/M, and also one [redacted] B/M, 34 yrs., of apt. [redacted] - [redacted] Both men stated that around 7:30AM, this morning, they heard popping sounds and smelled smoke while in their apartments. They stated that they opened the door and looked into the hallway and observed flames in the immediate doorway of complainant's apartment ([redacted] [redacted] further stated that

August 6, 1977

then ran back into his apartment and filled several containers with water and he returned to the hallway and doused the fire several times and [REDACTED], in turn, contacted the Fire Department. These two gentlemen, were in fact, the ones complainant spoke through the door. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] stated that the fire was put out completely by them before the arrival of the firemen. Same slightly smoldering upon the arrival of the Fire Department.

The rubbish, upon our arrival had been scraped together and placed together in a normal size garbage can for removal. Lt. Starkey, Sgt. Puhfal of the North Command had retrieved several round of .22 ammunition, same unexploded and aslo, several bullets in smashed condition, which had apparently struck concrete of hallway as to exploding during the fire. These bullets were retrieved and in custody in the Property Clerk's Office of this department.

Further conversation with the complainant revealed that he has received several threatening letters from an apparently unknown persons in eregards to doing damage to him. Said letters are signed, "Your brother Deso Demesmutz." It should be stated, for the purpose of this report, that the type of letter received are of the same type letters received in C&R#: 20292 - DD#: 2144-N, dated April 24, 1977. In this particular case, SAmuel Carr, W/M, 63 yrs., of [REDACTED] is the complainant, Dets assigned are R. Baker and W. Kennedy; also M. Lorenzo doing follow-up regarding these threatening letters. Inthat reports, indications are that one David Berkowitz, W/M, 24 yrs., of age, of # [REDACTED] Apt. [REDACTED] might be the perpetrator sending threatening letters. Mr. Berkowitz drives a 1974 Yellow, registration [REDACTED] NY Registration. Merkowitz DOB is [REDACTED]. Several other letters that Mr. Glassman received are in custody of the Westchester County Sheriff's Department where he is employed with Corporal Status. Deputy Sheriff David Feliciano, Sheriff's Office is handling letters investigation for Sheriff's Department. Letter recovered this date, matches samples in April 1977 threatening letters case involving Mr. Carr.

August 6, 1977

Photographer from the Fire Department was at scene and took pictures of damage before the rubbish was removed and placed in garbage can.

Apparently, David Berkowitz, who lives immediately above, apt. [REDACTED] of the complainant is possibly the responsible person.

Letter sent is in custody of the assigned, indicates Berkowitz, if he did write this one and those referred in the April 1977 job, has severe mental problems. According to Det. M. Lorenzo, he has samples (handwriting) and also copies of original letters sent to FBI Offices for analysis.

Please refer to April 1977 threatening letter job in cross reference in regards to suspected arson.

The assigned questioned several other tenants on the floor but no one saw nor heard anything other than the previously mentioned [REDACTED] - [REDACTED] couple. The assigned and Det. Lorenzo proceeded to Apt. [REDACTED] in an attempt to locate one David Berkowitz, unable, at this time to locate Berkowitz at home. A check of the immediate area revealed his car previously mentioned not in parking lot or general vicinity of the Pine Street address.

Lt. Starkey of the Fire Department retrieved piece of carpet which lines entire hallway and sent same to Lab to be tested to see if accelerant was used to start fire, but in his opinion he does not think so, at this time.

This investigation to be continued by Det. Mike Lorenzo and also Jose Feliciano of the Sheriff's Department who came to this office approximately 11:30AM, this date and was filled in as to the progress of both threatening letters and arson investigation, as aforesaid, Sheriff's Department is conducting their own investigation in regards to threatening letters received by the complainant on other dates. The information which he relayed from those letters and which are in the custody of the Sheriff's Department indicate to Det. Lorenzo that responsible persons wrote same to Carr-complainant in April 77 Job and also wrote letter found in this complainant's apartment this date, and same attached to and made a part of this report.

This investigation continuing.

June 10, 1977 -

The assigned, this date, at 0945 hours, met with complainant at the Detective Division relative to new information on letters that he had received on April 10th and 19th, complaining about his dog's barking on his property. Complainant's dog was shot on April 27, 1977 (C&R#: 21409). Mr. Carr stated that he was contacted by a Mrs. Jack Cassara of [REDACTED] relative to a Get-Well Card sent to her on June 6, 1977 and with the return address of Mr. & Mrs. Samuel Carr, [REDACTED]. The letter in essence stated:

Dear Jack: I'm sorry to hear about that fall you took from the roof of your home. Just want to say I'm sorry but I'm sure it won't be long until you feel much better, happy, well and strong. Please be careful next time since you are going to be confined for a long time, let us know if Nan needs anything. Sincerely, Sam and Francis". Mr. Carr stated to Mrs. Cassara that he does not know her and they arranged a meeting on the night of June 9, 1977 to compare handwriting on envelope with letters received by Mr. Carr. It should be noted that the writing and the return address appears to be the same type that was in the threatening letters of these reports. Ms. Cassara stated that she had a tenant in January and February of 1976 whose name was David R.
